STOMACH BUG

There have been quite a few children away with vomiting and/or diarrhoea. To stop sickness from spreading, it is important for you to keep your child at home when they are ill and not let them come to school. The following is the advice from the Ministry of Health on how to minimise the spread of illness.

Gastroenteritis (viral)

- **Symptoms appear after 1–3 days**
- **Infectious while vomiting and diarrhoea last, and up to 48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting**

Keep child home until well and for 48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting.
